Fulbright Fellowship Program 2025

The Royal Civil Service Commission (RCSC) is pleased to announce the availability of (contingent on funding) scholarships for Master's Degree (1-2 years program) as follows:

- 1. Scholarship areas:
 - Economic Development;
 - Public Administration; and
 - Urban and Regional Planning.

2. Eligibility criteria:

- Must have completed an equivalent of a U.S. bachelor's degree (four-year bachelor's degree or other equivalent) from a recognized university with at least 55% marks;
- Must have at least two years' full-time professional work experience relevant to your proposed field of study at the time of application;
- Demonstrate experience in leadership and community service;
- Must not have another degree from a U.S. university or be enrolled in a U.S. degree program; and
- If the applicant is employed, please obtain the endorsement from the appropriate administrative authority. The employer must indicate that leave will be granted for the fellowship period.

3. General Requirements (in addition to program requirements in Sl.2)

- Applicants from the civil service must fulfill the in-service training eligibility criteria as per BCSR 2023; and
- Applicants from the private and corporate sectors must fulfill the requirements specified by the Department of Workforce Planning and Skills Development, MoESD

4. Scholarship benefits:

- J-1 visa support;
- Round-trip economy class air travel from fellow's home city to the host institution in the United States;

- Accident and sickness coverage per U.S. Government guidelines.

★ Placement of successful candidates is done by the Institute of International Education (IIE). Recommended applicants do not need to apply to U.S. institutions on their own. IIE/Fulbright Program will apply to four different institutions on their behalf, taking into consideration the candidates' competitiveness and desired field of study. If a recommended candidate has previously applied to U.S. institutions and has requested a deferral from the institution, the candidate should notify the U.S. Embassy New Delhi immediately.

7. Important notes:

- An applicant can apply for only one Fulbright Master's fellowship category during a competition cycle;
- Plagiarism will lead to automatic disqualification;
- There is no designated slot for each scholarship area;
- Extension and transfer of VISA sponsorship will not be permitted;
- Applications received after the deadline will not be considered; and
- It must be noted that the candidates who get through the selection interview just get nominated for the fellowship. Therefore, the selected candidate must understand that his/her actual enrollment is subject to final confirmation.
- The scholarship is provided under the funding of Fulbright Foreign Students Fellowship Program and all scholarship entitlements are confined to those offered by them.
