The Human Resource Development Division, Royal Civil Service Commission is pleased to announce the availability of **King's Scholarship** slots for the academic session 2025. All class XII graduates of 2024 (not repeaters) from both within and outside the country meeting the eligibility criteria are encouraged to apply online via <https://www.citizenservices.gov.bt>. Navigate to 'KS and UG scholarships (RCSC)' under 'Education & Learning' and select the appropriate application form. The application portal will be opened from 03 February to 17 February 2025.

Eligibility criteria for King's Scholarship 2025

The selection will consist of the following processes:

1. Psychometric test
2. Viva-voce

1. Psychometric test

- Candidates who meet the following criteria will be eligible to take the psychometric test, which will be coordinated by the Jigme Singye Wangchuck School of Law (JSWSL):
 - Must have achieved an aggregate score of 81% or higher in the BHSEC-2024, with at least 60% in English and 70% in three relevant subjects, as specified in the eligibility criteria above.
 - Must apply to only one field of study.
 - Must be within the top 30 candidates in the applied field of study to be shortlisted for the psychometric test.
 - Candidates must have successfully paid the Administrative Fee for the Psychometric Test, amounting to Nu. 500 (five hundred only), within the specified deadline (which will be communicated to the shortlisted participants).

2. Viva voce

- The top ten candidates from each field, based on their psychometric test scores, will be invited to the selection interview (Viva-voce).
 - As a part of the final selection, final shortlisted candidates are required to sit for an essay writing assessment administered by the RCSC.
- The selection of the candidates for the scholarship will be determined by the total scores obtained in the final interview (as per the interview format).
