Foreword



In accordance with the provisions of The Constitution of The Kingdom of Bhutan, Civil Service Act of Bhutan 2010 and the procedures laid down in the Bhutan Civil Service Rules and Regulations 2023, the Royal Civil Service Commission administered the recruitment and selection of university graduates into the Civil Service annually through Bhutan Civil Service Examination (BCSE).

The Royal Civil Service Commission is pleased to publish its “13th Graduate Performance Report for the BCSE, 2024”.

This graduate performance report is published every year with the aim to serve as an advisory reference for parents, and prospective candidates to choose their educational pathway for a career into the Civil Service.

1. Preliminary Examination (PE)



The Preliminary Examination(PE) is the first phase of the selection process, which is conducted to shortlist candidates for the Main Examination (ME) to ensure the minimum standard required of a candidate is maintained for standardizing the entry of graduates into the civil service.

PE paper is common to all categories of graduates. PE consists of 100 objective-type questions for 100 marks which are designed to test Dzongkha and English communication skills, logic and analytical skills, problem-solving, data interpretation abilities, and the current affairs and general awareness of the candidates. The duration of the examination is 150 minutes.

PE levels out the differences and variations in subject difficulty levels, assessment schemes, and educational standards and quality and provides a level playing field for graduates to compete for the ME. It ensures that graduates meet the minimum core competency standards required of them for recruitment into the Civil Service.

The Preliminary Examination for the BCSE 2024 was conducted on August 3, 2024 in Thimphu and Mongar. A total of nine schools under the Thimphu Thromde and one school at Mongar were used as the examination center to accommodate 4099 graduates.

Of the 4841 graduates registered for the Preliminary Examination of BCSE 2024, 742 were absent during the conduct of the PE. A total of 541 graduates (358 B.Ed, 33 MBBS, and 150 Nursing) were exempted from the Preliminary Examination, who appeared only in the Main Examination(ME).

The cut-off percentage for the BCSE 2024 Preliminary Examination was set at 50% and 2686 graduates qualified for the Main Examination.

2. Main Examination



I) Background

The Main Examination (ME) tests the candidate's core competencies and subject/general knowledge for final selection. Candidates appearing in the ME are grouped under the following categories:

- a. General Category (Administrative Services, Financial Services, PGDE);
- b. B.Ed;
- c. Technical; and
- d. Dzongkha.

The final selection of the graduates to be recruited into the civil service shall be computed as follows:

Component	AS/FS/TS/PGDE	B.Ed
Part I: Academic Achievement	10 %	20 %
Part II: Written Examination	70 %	60 %
Part III: Viva -Voce	20 %	20 %

a) General Category

The ME for general graduates opting for the Administrative Service (AS), Finance Service (FS), and Education Service (ES) for PGDE, shall appear for examinations according to eligibility. The written examination shall comprise of the following three papers for a duration of three hours each. Each paper shall carry equal weightage and be evaluated out of 100 marks and the aggregate of the three papers shall be converted to 70% to obtain the total marks for the WE.

Paper I : Dzongkha;
 Paper II : English and General Knowledge; and
 Paper III : Bhutan and its (i) Socio-Political Institutions and (ii) Socio-Economic Development.

b) B.Ed (Dzongkha and General - Two Categories)

The ME for B.Ed. graduates opting for Education Services shall comprise the following three papers. Each paper shall carry equal weightage and be evaluated out of 100 marks and the aggregate of the three papers shall be converted to 60% to obtain the total marks for the WE.

In the B.Ed Category, two subjects need to have a separate question paper in accordance with their subject (Dzongkha/General) specialization. However, Paper III is standard for all.

Paper I : English Language;
 Paper II : Dzongkha Language; and
 Paper III : Teacher Aptitude Test.

c) Technical

The ME for technical graduates opting for the Technical Service shall comprise the following three papers. Each paper shall be evaluated out of 100 marks and converted to the respective scale of 20% for Paper I, 15% for Paper II, and 35% for Paper III, and then added to obtain the total marks for the WE.

Paper I : Language and General Knowledge (Common Paper - 20%);
Paper II : General Subject Knowledge (Common Paper for each professional group-15%);
Paper III : Subject Specialisation Paper (Subject specific – 35%).

d) Dzongkha

The ME for Dzongkha graduates (TS) opting for appointment in positions requiring Dzongkha specialization and Education Service shall comprise of the following three papers. Each paper shall be evaluated out of 100 marks and converted to the respective scale of 20% for Paper I, 15% for Paper II, and 35% for Paper III and then added to obtain the total marks for the WE.

Paper I : Dzongkha Language and General Knowledge (20%);
Paper II : English Language and Current Affairs (15%); and
Paper III : Buddhist Studies (35%).
