**MBBS Slot Availability at General Sir John Kotelawala Defence University (KDU)
and University of Kelaneya, Sri Lanka**

The Royal Civil Service Commission (RCSC) is pleased to announce the availability of **up to five (5)** slots for pursuing the **Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS)** program at **General Sir John Kotelawala Defence University (KDU), Sri Lanka**, for the 2025–2026 academic year. These slots are offered under the framework of the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) signed between RCSC and KDU. Please note that candidates selected under this program will be responsible for covering tuition fees, travel, and living expenses.

Eligibility Criteria

- Must be students from the 2024 BHSEC (Class XII) cohort
- A minimum of 65% in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology, and at least 55% in English
- Repeaters, and candidates who have already been awarded scholarships are not eligible
- Selection will be made strictly on merit ranking

Application Submission:

Eligible candidates are required to submit their applications in hard copy to the Human Resource Development Division (HRDD), RCSC by 22-May-2025, along with the following documents:

1. Class XII mark sheet and certificate
2. Class X mark sheet and pass certificate
3. Migration certificate*
4. English Language Proficiency Certificate**
5. Medical fitness certificate
6. Copy of Bhutanese Citizenship Card

Notes:

*Migration Certificate will be issued by your Class XII school.

**The English Language Proficiency Certificate is issued by the BCSEA.
