MBBS Slot Availability at University of Kelaniya, Sri Lanka (Self-Funding)

The Royal Civil Service Commission (RCSC) is pleased to announce the availability of 13 slots for pursuing the Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS) program at the Faculty of Medicine, University of Kelaniya, Sri Lanka, for the 2026–2027 academic year.

These slots are offered under the framework of the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) signed between RCSC and the University of Kelaniya. Please note that candidates have to cover all the expenses (tuition fees, travel, and living expenses, etc.)

Eligibility Criteria:

- Must be students from the 2025 BHSEC (Class XII) cohort
- A minimum of 65% in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology, and at least 55% in English
- Repeaters, and candidates who have already been awarded scholarships are not eligible
- Selection will be made strictly on merit ranking

Application Submission:

Eligible candidates are required to submit their applications in hard copy to the Human Resource Development Division (HRDD), RCSC by 15 June 2026, along with the following documents:

1. Class XII mark sheet and pass certificate
2. Class X mark sheet and pass certificate
3. Migration certificate*
4. English Language Proficiency Certificate**
5. Medical fitness certificate
6. Copy of Bhutanese Citizenship Card

Notes:

*Migration Certificate will be issued by your Class XII school.

**The English Language Proficiency Certificate is issued by the BCSEA.
